#### 2. SUPERINTENDENT'S COMMENTS

Thomas McDaid, Assistant Superintendent for Business, explained that all districts receiving over a 10% increase in Foundation Aid must create a plan to show exactly how these funds are allocated. The plan, which will be posted on the district website, will differentiate allocations between the schools, districtwide services, and summer programs. For the American Rescue Plan, the district must create a plan to spread the state funding over three years, and this plan will also be posted on the district website.
