What is the NYSSMA Solo and Ensemble Festival?

The New York State School Music Association (NYSSMA) sponsors a festival each spring which provides students the opportunity to perform solos and small ensembles (duets, trios, etc.) for an impartial adjudication. Judges hear each student play or sing a graded selection from the NYSSMA manual, a short sight-reading selection (8 measures), and instrumentalists will need to perform scales. Students are then given a written report with comments on their performance and a grade. Grades range from the relatively rare Outstanding through Excellent, Good, Satisfactory, and Fair (A+ through C- in Levels V and VI).

Levels I - very easy - elementary

II - easy - advanced elementary, middle school

III - medium - middle school

IV - medium difficult - advanced middle school, high school

V - difficult - advanced high school

VI - very difficult - only for the most advanced soloists

NYSSMA festival grades provide a standard that is used for acceptance to All-County festivals, many music camps, and can be included in college applications.

Students participating in the NYSSMA festival (and their parents) should be aware of the following:

- 1. The 2023 festival will be conducted in-person at Grand Avenue Middle School.
- 2. All solos must be listed in the current NYSSMA Manual. Check this carefully with your **school music teacher**. The current manual is **Edition 33.** Private teachers do not always have the current manual.
- 3. <u>Private lessons are strongly encouraged</u>, but not required for NYSSMA participation. We can provide a list of private tutors whom we recommend. 4th grade band and orchestra students should have a private tutor to be adequately prepared for the festival.
- 4. It is your responsibility to purchase an original copy of the solo. IF YOUR PIECE IS MEMORIZED you will still need an original copy. Photocopies are not permitted.
- 5. Scores will not be posted at the festival. Students will receive their scores and comment sheets from their teachers during the following week at school.
