9. REPORT OF COMMITTEES

Trustee Ed Corona announced that John DeTommaso, Superintendent of Schools for the Bellmore-Merrick Central High School District, is retiring effective June 30, 2021. Mr. Corona said Mr. DeTommaso has done a wonderful job during his tenure, bringing innovative programs to the district. He stated that Michael Harrington, Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum, has been appointed to replace Mr. DeTommaso, which will ensure a seamless transition of leadership. Mr. Corona also said that Dr. David Goldberg, a social studies teacher at Calhoun High School, has received the Distinguished Alumni Award for Public Service from Binghamton State University.

Ed Corona highlighted the many PTA-sponsored events taking place throughout the district. He noted that the Parent University was scheduled for November 16 as "A Night of Virtual Wellness," which includes a keynote speaker, workshops and yoga. In addition, he commented that remote instruction is going very well with a teacher for every grade level, and there is a very innovative and creative classroom environment for both remote and in-school learning.

Samuel Carder, Director of School Facilities, reported that district operations are running smoothly. He said the cost of the lighting project in the Old Mill Road gymnasium will be largely reimbursed through a PSE&G rebate program, and the maintenance crew is replenishing the wood fiber ground covering in all the district playgrounds. Mr. Carder complimented the crew for having the foresight to salvage parts during the bond project, which are now being utilized for the compressor project at Fayette. In addition, he said the work on the New York State Smart Bond Act project is starting at Old Mill Road, which he explained is a districtwide data project to improve infrastructure, update wiring, and improve Wi-Fi.

Mr. Carder said that the Election Day voting locations at Fayette and Old Mill Road went well, and the custodial staff was able to do deep cleaning at Camp Avenue that day. He said the head custodians and District Clerk, Joanne Long, were well prepared for the day of the vote.

Mr. Carder noted that the reopening task force and subcommittees started meeting in June, and he said it is very rewarding to see how far the district has come over these several months thanks to the involvement of the task force members.
