6. BUSINESS

- A. The Board of Education enters into an agreement with Omni Group as a third party administrator of the district's 403(b) plan from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023, at a rate of \$33.00 per account, not to exceed \$4,800.00.
- B. The Board of Education approves to continue its membership in the Nassau County Schools Cooperative Self-Insurance Plan for workers' compensation for the 2022-23 school year pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Nassau County Schools Cooperative Self-Insurance Plan for workers' compensation agreement dated February 9, 2016.
- C. The Board of Education enters into an agreement with Merrick Woods Country Day School, Inc. for the use of the fields at H. D. Fayette School during the 2022 summer.
- D. The Board of Education enters into an agreement with Merrick Woods Country Day School, Inc. for use of 25 designated car parking spaces and 4 bus parking spaces during the 2022 summer.

- E. The Board of Education authorizes the continuation of the agreement with New York Schools Insurance Reciprocal for the 2022-23 school year. Cost not to exceed \$170,000.
- F. The Board of Education authorizes the continuation of the agreement with Travelers Casualty & Surety Co. of America for commercial crime coverage for the 2022-23 school year. Cost not to exceed \$7,500.

- L. The Board of Education approves the annually employed, part-time, and non-aligned employees be compensated at the increased hourly rate, as detailed in the mailing. Compensation will be effective for the 2022-23 school year for all current employees.
- M. The Board of Education authorizes the District to enter into a 12-month agreement for disability benefits and paid family leave insurance with New York State Insurance Fund, effective July 1, 2022.
- N. The Board of Education authorizes the budget transfer as follows: Account To: 2250.400.04; Contract Services; \$34,000. Account From: A2250.475.04; Tuition Other; \$34,000. Reason: Additional costs for therapy for special education students.
- O.
